




Under the conditions of building tradition discontinuity cultural heritage of Kaszuby and Żuławy requires careful research to study its origins, nature and evolution. The first step was the analysis of settlement types, their landscape characteristics, location and inner structure (road system, plots, places, fences, entrances, greenery etc.). Similar studies are concerned farmsteads, buildings and their layout, materials and construction, proportions and details. In each case it is important to identify specific local differences (the case study of Osiek village) The next step towards rebuilding local tradition is the development of design guidelines addressed to architects and investors. These guidelines are focused on extracting most important traditional elements, commonly used throughout the region (i.e. constitute building patterns), however distinct local features are also taken into consideration to allow for a range of variety.

The most demanding challenge concerns education aimed at helping people to identify themselves with forgotten rural heritage. This education is meant to develop basic understanding of traditional rural landscape and architecture including building layout, logic of construction and use of local materials, as well as heating system and detailing. A set of "good practice manuals" has been elaborated for different subregions of Kaszuby and Żuławy.
